Name: NRA Basics of Pistol Shooting – Phase 2

Short Description: The NRA Basics of Pistol Shooting is a two-part course consisting of a National Rifle Association (NRA) e-learning portion ([NRA Basics of Pistol Shooting - Phase I](#) completed online at your own pace) and a Bend of the River Conservation Club (BORCC) hands-on practical portion conducted at the club range under the guidance and supervision of an NRA-Certified Instructor. The course is intended for all adults regardless of previous shooting experience or NRA or BORCC affiliation.

More Details: Some of the topics in the course include: gun safety rules, proper operation of revolvers and semi-automatic pistols, ammunition knowledge and selection, selecting and storing a pistol, the fundamentals of shooting, and pistol inspection and maintenance. When you enroll in the NRA online course, you create a personal identification number (PIN). When you successfully complete the course, printing your certificate activates that PIN. The activated PIN allows you to register for the instructor-led training portion of the course conducted at BORCC.

During the instructor-led-training portion of the course, an NRA Certified Instructor will validate comprehension and application of gun safety rules; range protocol; proper handling; loading and unloading procedures; application of pistol shooting fundamentals; stable shooting positions; live fire; and a final shooting qualification.

BORCC Phase 2 Registration: The registration process for this course requires **two (2)** registrations:

- Registration 1) Complete this registration form and send it with payment to BORCC.

BORCC Phase 2 Course Preparation: Students should bring a pistol in good working order and approximately 100 rounds of “factory” ammunition (Full Metal Jacket). NO magnum caliber ammunition. If you don’t have a pistol, the club has several .22 caliber pistols made available through a NRA Grant. For club pistols you will need to bring .22 caliber (Long Rifle) ammunition (copper-plated bullet). A reservation is need for club pistol. There is no additional cost for using a club pistol. Also, eye and ear protection is needed. The club has eye and ear protection available to use if you need them.
