Short Description: Teaches the basic knowledge, skills, and attitude for owning and operating firearms safely. The WOT Instructional Shooting Clinic will also help prepare you for participation in other NRA Courses.

More Details: Women on Target is an instructional clinic designed to introduce women to the safe handling and shooting of firearms in a friendly, relaxed environment. Lessons are given by experienced, certified instructors and each participant is given individualized attention on the range. Our primary goal is to teach you how to handle and shoot a variety of firearms safely, in a laid-back, fun environment.

- Learn safe firearms handling
- Learn how to store your firearms safely
- Learn to shoot
- Learn a sport you'll enjoy for a lifetime

Course Preparation: There is no need to bring any firearms or ammunition to this course. The Bend of the River Conservation Club and the National Rifle Association (NRA) provide firearms, ammunition, and safety equipment. The primary firearms are .22 caliber pistols. Safety equipment consists of eye and ear protection. Prescription glasses may be worn for eye protection. You may bring your own ear protection equipment. Please wear long pants with pockets, closed toe shoes (no flip flops or sandals), and a crew neck (T-shirt) or button-up shirt (no low-cut neck lines).

Course Registration: Pre-registration is required. Space is limited and all seats will be filled on a first-paid basis. We cannot accept walk-in sign-ups on the day of the event. Participants must be at least 18 years of age (16 – 17 years of age allowed, if accompanied by parent or guardian).

Basic Safety:**The Fundamental NRA Rules for Safe Gun Handling Are:**

- ALWAYS Keep the Gun Pointed in a Safe Direction.
- ALWAYS Keep Your Finger Off the Trigger Until Ready to Shoot.
- ALWAYS Keep the Firearm Unloaded Until Ready to Use.
